General Description:

The TRIO Front Desk Assistant will engage and make genuine contact with students and visitors in the TRIO SSS Suite in Bessey 209 and those using the TRIO SSS Program Tutoring Center. TRIO Front Desk Assistants provide administrative support to TRIO SSS Program professional staff and TRIO SSS Scholars enrolled in the program. - Be knowledgeable of TRIO, NSSC and other campus resources to assist in student referrals
- Answer phones in a professional, polite, and efficient manner
- Schedule and manage flow of appointments for TRIO Peer Tutors
- Assist with sanitizing and upkeep of the TRIO Tutoring Center and office suite for COVID compliance
- Participate and engage in TRIO SSS programming, workshops, and outreach events
